

SPARKLING

GLASS 175ml BOTTLE

Prosecco Doc Millesime, Bepi Tempesta £9.9 £32

Glass option served in a small 20cl bottle.
Italy - Pale lemon colour It has floral aromas and hints of citrus and white stone fruits. On the palate is has peach and lemony flavours and lots of bubbles rounded off with a crisp finish.

Rosè Extyra Dry Millesimato, CON-TRE £8 £29

Italy - Light pink with tending to ruby with fine and persistent perlage, delicate scent, fresh and slightly vinous. It has a dry taste with a mature and very pleasant finish.

Champagne Extra Quality Brut £95

Brut, Ployez Jacquemart, Reims - France
Light yellow. Expressive nose, initially fruit-driven, raspberry, exotic touch, then opening up to toasted notes. Fleshy, melted attack leading into a firmer mid-palate. An excellent, fruit-forward Champagne.

ROSE

GLASS 175ml BOTTLE

Discovery Beach, White Zinfandel £8 £27

California - USA - Delightfully pink salmon colour, with a fresh bouquet of strawberries and ripe summer fruits on the nose. On the palate, it is bursting with flavour and has excellent balance.

Adele Rosè Pinot Grigio Blush £9.5 £29

Italy - The primary flavours of this rosé wine are wild berries (in particular wild strawberries), hints of roses, citrus and melon, with a pleasant crunchy green flavour on the finish similar to celery or rhubarb. Elegant and pleasantly aromatic, acidity and minerality are well balanced.

Cote de Provence Rosé, Domain Aspras £36

France (ORGANIC) - Highly popular wine. Light yellow colour with green reflections. Complex nose: exotic notes, fresh almonds and rhubarb. Good length with a fresh finish on notes of exotic fruits.

WHITE WINES

GLASS 175ml BOTTLE

Chardonnay Igt, Solum £8.5 £27

Italy - A simple white, with melon and honey character, light body and a light finish.

Kavaklidere Cankaya, Narince £9.5 £29

Turkey - The favourite wine of Turkey. Produced from Emir, Narince & sultana grapes. A pleasant fruit driven white with notes of apple, peach & pear alongside the citrus fruits.

Pinot Grigio, Vigna di riva £9.5 £29

Italy - A dry white wine with an intense floral perfume and an agreeable scent of golden apple and yellow flower notes. It's a very adaptable wine which pairs well with light dishes.

Garganega Sauvignon La Cappuccina £12 £36

Italy (ORGANIC) - Aromatic and elegant bouquet, balanced, smooth and well-structured on the palate. It has precise perfumes, with dominant notes of citrus fruits and warm graphite, along with hints of tropical fruits and hawthorn.

Verdejo, Menade, Rued £12 £36

Spain (ORGANIC) - Fresh stone fruit aromas with notes of fennel and thyme. The palate is ripe and textural with white peach and herbal characters, balanced by crisp acidity and minerality.

Picpoul de Pinet Moulin de Gassac £39

France - Light and crispy, it has clean and fresh, bright minerality notes in both the nose and mouth. Flavours of green and honeydew melon and citrus flavours and a crisp, zesty acidity.

Gavi di Gavi Docg, La Chiara £48

Italy - Pale lemon with green tints. Elegant bouquet with hints of apple and floral notes. The palate is medium-bodied with citrus, galia melon and apricot flavours, backed by good acidity and the classic Gavi taste of bitter almonds.

Cotes du Rhône Blanc, Le GraveireFe £75

France (Organic/Biodinamyc) - The nose is fruity with notes of citrus fruits and white flowers, with the lift coming from the Clairette grape. In the mouth, the wine is lively, fat and generous! An intriguing wine, for interested wine lovers.

RED WINES

GLASS 175ml BOTTLE

Merlot Igt, Solum £8 £28

Italy - Clean, well-defined Merlot, with currant, dried herbs and a hint of tar. A light-bodied wine with a fresh and fruity palate.

Kavaklidere, Yakut, Okuzgozu £9 £29

Turkey - A legendary wine from eastern Anatolia, made from 'Öküzgözü' grapes. A medium bodied ruby red wine with intense red fruit aromas, accompanied with spice.

Bericanto, Pinot Noir Docg, Veneto £11 £33

Italy - A unique Pinot "Noir", made by careful selection of grapes from the most suitable areas of the hills of the Veneto region.

Merlot, Adele, Cà Vescovado £12 £35

Italy - Intense ruby red colour with purplish-blue glints. The bouquet is generous, with pleasant notes of vibrant red berries, cherry, blueberry and plum.

Sol De Mayo, Malbec £39

Argentina - Fruity notes of morello cherries and raspberries combined with hints of vanilla. A well balanced, persistent, fruit driven, complex harmonious finish

Rioja Montebuena, Tempranillo Maturado £41

Spain - Very floral with red/blackberries, hints of graphite and a hint of dried grass. The palate is fresh with fruit flavours, with a touch of dry hay and well-defined tannins in the finish.

Bordeaux, Per Vitem Ad Vitam 2016 £57

Côtes de Bourg - France - Chateau Gros Moulin Per Vitem ad Vitam is a beautifully balanced and structured wine with a great nose of smoke, spice and liquorice.

Amarone della Valpolicella, Tinazzi £88

Italy - Strong notes of cherry jam combined with the typical notes of dried fruit to create a large and complex bouquet, enriched with sweet spicy notes such as liquorice and vanilla.

Barolo di Barolo Docg, Virna Borgogno £129

Italy - A masterpiece of balance and harmony. A true expression of terroir and Nebbiolo character. In the glass, it is a ruby-red colour with mahogany edges typical of Nebbiolo and a rich bouquet of rose and spice.
